

AN INVESTIGATION OF ASIA-PACIFIC TELECOM ENHANCEMENTS FOR E-LEARNING NETWORKS

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ABSTRACT

This research explores how Asia-Pacific telecommunications companies have impacted & can influence the development of robust e-learning network environments. We also discuss an e-learning framework for trans-national learning & knowledge management opportunities. Three key topics are discussed: First, to discuss how *corporations* are leveraging telecommunication resources to enhance & to supplement corporate learning; second, to share how *academic institutions* in the Asia-Pacific region are leveraging telecommunication resources to enhance & to supplement classroom learning; and third, to articulate how corporations & academic institutions can collaborate to share & to learn from each other, given their respective e-learning environments.
